Please wear closed toes shoes that are comfortable for walking on hilly terrain. The site is a sunny, hilly 2 acres, so please dress accordingly.

Please carpool if possible. Good meeting point is BJ's Parking lot at North County Fair Mall at Highway 15 & Via Rancho Parkway.

Tour the year old farm that surrounds home. The farm is a mix of drought tolerant and edible plants arranged in a water wise fashion. Fruits that you will see: avocados, bananas, berries, cherimoya, citrus, figs, persimmons, grapes, guavas, and much, much more...

In March 2008, the Farrars decided to build a new home with the goal of a net zero energy design, surrounded by a sustainable farm to provide a carbon neutral footprint. Construction began in the spring of 2010 and the home was completed in the summer of 2011. The home is now complete and LEED Platinum certified.

A key element of the [Farrar Green Home](http://www.FarrarGreenHome.org) is the sustainable organic farm. The farm is intended to be relatively self-sufficient, growing the majority of the fruits and vegetables required by the Farrars. All of the flat areas of the 2 acre property are planted with edible trees and plants. The sloped areas are planted with low maintenance, drought tolerant plants and trees. The farm includes a wide variety of fruit trees, fruiting vines and berries. Unusual and heritage varieties of fruits and vegetables have been chosen so that the varieties of foods that are grown include those that are not commonly found in supermarkets.
